INTRODUCTION TO THE ANIMAL WORLD

What if we discovered the animal kingdom? A great activity to discover several species: reptiles, mammals and other classes.

PSST...

This presentation ends with a mini ferret show!

Animals:

1 to 2 lizard(s), 1 snake, 1 to 2 other specie(s) (bird, frog, turtle, etc.),
2 mammals and 1 ferret

Duration: 1h00 - 6 species / 1h30 - 7 species



Students will discover the senses with the help of the animals! During this activity, each presented species will be used to demonstrate one of the five senses (touch, smell, sight, taste and hearing). This presentation will allow students to recognize and distinguish them by observing these senses in different species.

Animals:

Bird, arthropod, small rodent, chinchilla or rabbit, snake, ferret

Duration: 1h00 - 6 species / 1h30 - 7 species

MAMMALS

Short haired, long haired or thorned? Regardless, we love them all! Through the visit, meet cute representatives of the mammal class.

Animals:

Rodents, rabbit, hedgehog, ferret, Brazilian possum

REPTILES

Scales and shells, do you find that strange? Through the visit, discover fascinating representatives of the reptile class. And who knows, maybe you'll catch yourself flicking out your tongue too...

Animals:

2 turtles, 2 to 3 lizards, 2 snakes

Duration: 1h00 - 6 species / 1h30 - 7 species

WINTER

Discover how animals survive the winter! This activity will talk about physical and physiological adaptations that animals developed to inhabit cold climates. Hibernation, estivation, short extremities, migration and other subjects will be discussed.

Animals:

Snail, amphibian, stick insect, aquatic turtle, blue-tongued skink, snake, Russian hamster, rats, chinchilla, rabbit and ferret

Duration: 1h00 - 6 species / 1h30 - 7 species

Students will follow the process from fish to bird. We will take them step by step on the history of evolution's journey. They may be surprised by the true order of events!

Animals:

DISGUISED ANIMALS

Students will have the chance to meet several animals who have disguises that allow them to go unnoticed or to pass a message. In this activity, students will discover the camouflage champions!

Animaux:

Stick insect, water dragon, frog, sand boa, hamster, gecko, rabbit and ferret

Duration: 1h00 - 6 species / 1h30 - 7 species

Animals:

Bearded dragon, domestic rat, stick insect, hermit crab, corn snake, hedgehog and ferret

Jump, crawl, stick, we don't judge you! What if walking was the least efficient way to get around? In this activity, meet animals that have developed innovative ways of locomotion.

Animals:


Reptiles, amphibians, arhtropods, etc.

Minimum 1h00: challenges + handling 4 species presented.

1h30 : challenges + handling 5 species presented.

2h00 : challenges + handling 6 species presented.







ENVIRONMENT

Do you want to educate your students to adopt responsible behavior towards our environment? In this activity, we illustrate how human activities impact animal species at different levels. We discuss pollution, deforestation, climate change, etc. A theme to build a better world!

Animals:

Bird, amphibian, arboreal lizard, snake, tegu, chinchilla or hedgehog, ferret and turtle or giant snail

Duration: 1h00 - 6 species / 1h30 - 7 species

A TRIP AROUND THE WORLD!

Students will meet a variety of species from all around the world. The discussion will be about how each species get adapted to its climate. A fascinating topic which can increase the awareness of students about climate change.
